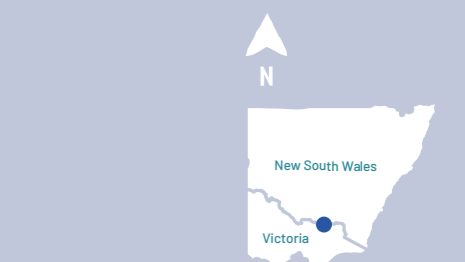

The Corowa Mulwala Cycle Trail is a family-friendly 43-km trail that skirts the northern bank of the Murray River and Lake Mulwala, linking the towns of Corowa and Mulwala.

Part of a new trail connecting Albury to Tocumwal via Howlong and Cobram Barooga, the trail is sealed and mostly flat, making it perfect for cycling buffs, as well as sightseers looking for a more leisurely way to explore this beautiful part of the world North of the Murray.
