# Water Adventures

Explore the meandering turns in the river, paddle the lush backwaters or let the adrenalin pulse on a fast-paced boating ride. In River Country it's 'aquatic playground meets river retreat'!

Bursting with beautiful waterways, River Country is home to the Murray, Edward, Wakool, Neimur and Murrumbidgee Rivers as well as the Merran and Billabong Creeks and various lakes.

## **CANOEING**

Our still waters deliver the perfect setting to escape civilisation and enjoy a refreshing aquatic-based experience. Opt for a canoe and venture off land, travelling along the mighty Murray or one of its many tributaries that span the region.

If a guided trail is more your style, try the Edward River Canoe Trail and savour the natural beauty of this unique river system and the surrounding river red gum forests.

## **STAND UP PADDLE BOARDING (SUP)**

This fun water-based activity is fast becoming the ultimate aquatic adventure and our river country offers the ideal location to start or step-up your paddle boarding game! All you need is a body of water and your equipment. No waves are required, making our riverside destination the perfect SUP environment. Find your happy place and enjoy spectacular views of the water and surrounding forest from your paddleboard.

## **WATER SKIING**

The beautiful, protected waters of the Murray near Moama and Mathoura are the perfect conditions for water skiers. The 15 hectare Moulamein Lake is also well suited to water skiing. Whether you're an absolute beginner or a seasoned expert, this is a fun and active way to spend the day. If you want to make the most of your water ski and wakeboard experience, you can also grab some lessons from the experts!

## **BOATING AND FISHING**

When it comes time to drop in a line, our secluded creeks and rivers boast some of the best inland fishing in Australia.

Our waterways are a breeding ground for native fish species including one of the most prized trophies, Australia's largest freshwater fish, the Murray Cod. Other species native to the region include the Redfin (English Perch), Silver Perch (Bream), Golden Perch (Yellowbelly), freshwater Murray Cray (season closed for 5 years) and the Yabby.

If fishing is not your game, and you just want to explore the elements of nature not accessible by road or foot, sit back and relax in your boat or tinny and let River Country take care of the rest!

# Fairways and Bunkers

Whether you're a golfing enthusiast or part-time putter, in River Country you'll find picture-perfect courses at your fingertips.

One of the jewels in the golfing crown is Rich River Golf Club at Moama which offers two distinct Par 72 championship golf courses that are immaculately groomed and playable all year round.

Another jewel is located at Murray Downs Golf and Country Club, just across the bridge from Swan Hill. This Par 72 course features large, well-manicured greens and rivals some of the best courses in Australia.

Barham also boasts a magnificent Par 73 championship course set amongst towering gum trees and scenic island greens. And at Tooleybuc, you'll discover a picturesque nine-hole course with Murray River views that all standards of golfers will love.

The Tooleybuc Sporting Club offers a 9 hole/twin tee golf course making for a pleasurable 18 holes of fun.

# Cultural Offerings

Our community is home to a diverse cultural scene; from talented artists, craftspeople, musicians and artisan traders, to amazing architecture and stories that have stood the test of time... it truly is an inspiring region to discover and explore.

## **THE BACKROADS TRAIL**

Take a detour off the beaten track and discover the wonder of the Backroads Trail. Meet the locals, taste the home-grown produce, sample the boutique wines and explore our rich cultural, artistic and social heritage. The trail also highlights the close ties farmers have with their land and the innovative ways in which they are working to ensure its sustainability for future generations.

The Backroads Trail is located in the rural area north of the Murray River between Barham, Moama, Mathoura and Deniliquin. It's simple to navigate and offers a true farm gate experience!

## **LONG PADDOCK TOURING ROUTE**

This well-known touring experience follows the stock route along the Cobb Highway from Echuca Moama on the Victorian border all the way through to Wilcannia, and the iconic outback towns of Bourke, Broken Hill and White Cliffs.

There are 11 major public artworks along the route, reflecting the heart and soul of our small rural communities. The route also showcases a series of timber sculptures, designed to pay tribute to the significant economic and social contribution of the timber industry to the region.

## THE ARTS SCENE

Murray River Country is home to an inspired community of artists, musicians, crafters and creatives who inject life and colour into our country markets, concert halls and galleries.

If you're a lover of the performing arts, you'll be welcomed with open arms by our local theatre companies in Echuca Moama and Barham as they intertwine old favourites and contemporary pieces that transport you to the fun and vibrant world of make-believe.

In Moama, momentum is building for a developing public art project based around the new Echuca Moama bridge crossing. This exciting art space will deliver a contemporary visual art-based record of the region's pre and post-colonial cultural development with a focus on the rich traditions of the Yorta Yorta Nation.

If you head a little further north to Moulamein, you'll discover a unique little art gallery bursting at the seams with character. It's the perfect destination to indulge in coffee and cake while you take in the vibrant displays from local talent and artisans.

## INDIGENOUS CULTURE

Welcome to Yorta Yorta, Wamba Wamba and Barapa Barapa country.

Murray River Council acknowledges the traditional owners on whose land we live, work and explore, and their rich culture and spiritual connection to country. We pay our respects to Elders past and present and celebrate their living culture and unique role in the life of our region.

The Indigenous people of Murray River Country have a close affinity with the rivers and landscapes of this unique natural environment. Dhungala, the mighty waterway known today as the Murray River, winds its way through Yorta Yorta, Wamba Wamba and Barapa Barapa Traditional Lands where the original inhabitants and custodians have lived for tens of thousands of years.

The Murray River and its environs are full of artefacts and evidence of Aboriginal habitation. Scarred trees, shell middens, cooking mounds, burial grounds, marker trees and sacred sites are all obvious reminders of the long and careful association and occupation of this land by the ancestors of the Yorta Yorta, Wamba Wamba and Barapa Barapa peoples.

2. Taste your way through the plethora of delicious local food and wine offerings.
3. Experience the river in any manner of ways (historic paddlesteamer cruise, fishing, paddleboarding, fish and chips on the riverbank, waterskiing, or a refreshing swim).
4. Immerse yourself in Moama's colourful history by taking a self-drive tour through **Old Moama** (eastern end of Chanter Street). Visit **Maiden's Punt Reserve**, wander around the restored **Old Telegraph Station**, and the picturesque **River Captain's Cottage**.
5. Visit **Horseshoe Lagoon** in the heart of Moama. This wetland and floodplain reserve is a relaxing nature experience and an important and productive ecosystem.

There are also a number of significant creeks that run via the town which are great places to fish for Murray Cod, Golden Perch (Yellowbelly), Silver Perch (Bream), Redfin (English Perch), freshwater Murray Crayfish and yabbies.
2. Follow one of the **walking tracks**, or explore one of the **scenic drives** throughout the region.
3. Enjoy some classic **country hospitality** at the local services club or hotel. Wakool is a popular stop over point for travellers.
4. Join in one of Wakool's **annual events**, including the popular **Fishing Classic**, **Wakool Sheep Races**, or bowls tournaments.

3. Drop into the cellar door of **Andrew Peace Wines** (Piangil), one of Australia's largest family-owned wineries. BBQ and pizza oven available on request.
4. Visit the **Bridge Keepers Cottage Community Op Shop** located in a charming heritage building, with a rich history.
5. Be amazed at the size of the **Giant Mallee Root** (the biggest stump in NSW and second largest in the world according to the Guinness World Records) and learn all about the rare and endangered **Dinosaur Ant**. Both are on display at the Tooleybuc Sports Club.
6. Built in 1925, the heritage-listed **Tooleybuc Bridge** is a timber truss and steel lift-span bridge over the Murray River. The bridge is of technical significance for its sophisticated design and construction. It was the last of a series of bridges over the Murray River that incorporated central lift spans with innovative truss spans.

# MURRAY VALLEY NATIONAL AND REGIONAL PARKS

## Reed Beds Bird Hide – Mathoura



It's a haven for birds and bird-watchers alike! The Reed Beds Bird Hide, situated in the national park, just off Picnic Point Road allows you to view the wetland without disturbing the local wildlife. Follow the interpretive boardwalk and soak up this spectacular site. The Eastern Great Egret and Cattle Egret are known to nest here while the wetland also provides important foraging and habitat opportunities for a range of fauna including the White-bellied Sea Eagle, Sacred Kingfisher and Royal Spoonbill. Please do not bring your dog to Reed Beds Bird Hide.

## Swifts Creek Campground and Picnic Area – Mathoura



This campground is situated in the national park on the Murray River and is ideal for those looking for a campground with facilities. The boat ramp is an ideal spot to launch into the Murray, or fish from the decks either side. It is a short drive to many of the park's attractions from here. You might like to drop your kayak in the river at the Picnic Point boat ramp, and paddle down the Murray River back to Swifts Creek campground. This is a national park – dogs are not permitted.

## Benarca – Moama



Just a short distance from Moama. Enjoy magnificent views of the Murray River as you wait for the fish to bite. You can swim from the sandy beach, stroll through the forest and settle in for a night under the stars. Pitch a tent, bring your campervan or caravan. This is in a regional park - dogs are permitted but must remain on a leash.

## Edward River Bridge Campground and Picnic Area – Mathoura



This is the ideal place to set up camp, enjoy a barbeque and explore the forest around you. Take your kayak and launch into the Edward River using the new wheelchair accessible launch. The riverside campground is just a few kilometres from town and even closer to the Reed Beds Bird Hide. Take the journey of the history of the forests with our interpretive sculpture. This is in a regional park - dogs are permitted but must remain on a leash.

## Willoughbys Beach – Deniliquin



Experience the natural beauty of Deniliquin's River Red Gum forests along Willoughby's Beach walk, which forms part of the Beach to Beach walk. Willoughby's Beach is a great location to set up camp alongside the Edward River. From here you can walk along the many forest tracks, ride along the Deniliquin Mountain Bike Trails or launch your boat. This is in a regional park - dogs are permitted but must remain on a leash.

## Moama Five Mile – Moama



Ideal for a picnic along the Murray River, Moama Five Mile has something for everyone, offering a striking setting to cast a line under the shade of River Red Gums. Home to seven kilometres of world class mountain bike tracks suitable for the whole family and easy boating access, Moama Five Mile is a great spot to enjoy all the mighty Murray has to offer. This is in a regional park - dogs are permitted but must remain on a leash.
