THE BEST RIVER BEACHES IN AUSTRALIA

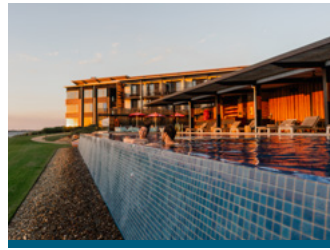

You can experience everything from the secluded bush settings through to more accessible beaches such as one of Australia's top 100 beaches; Thompson's Beach in Cobram.

The twin towns of Yarrowonga Mulwala sit idyllically on either side of the Murray River, with Lake Mulwala adding to the mesmerising backdrop and creating a genuine aquatic paradise.

Also nestled by the Murray River are the townships of Cobram Barooga and Tocumwal, where you can relax at the countless sandy beaches dotted along the river, savour delicious produce straight from the Murray Farm Gate Trail and visit nearby villages of Barmah, Berrigan, Finley, Nathalia and Numurkah – all part of this beautiful region.

NATURE

Get ready to be mesmerized by the grandeur of the Murray River, the 3rd longest navigable river in the world!

Surrounded by the breathtaking beauty of nature, you'll be reinvigorated by exploring our pristine waterways, river beaches and tranquil bushlands.

A vast network of tracks and trails weave along the rivers ensuring that the waterways can be accessed all year round and by all ages.

Experience the world's largest stand of River Red Gums in the Barmah National Park, which forms part of an internationally recognised RAMSAR wetlands area.

Sun Country is a popular region for koala and kangaroo spotting. An early morning or late afternoon to Ulupna Island or Thompson's Beach will not disappoint, with sightings of kangaroos and koalas a common occurrence.



BOATING, CAMPING, AND FISHING

We feature Victoria's most accessible river banks of the Murray River enabling the best boating, camping and fishing experience.

The river beaches stretch hundreds of kilometres from Bundalong to Barmah, with free dispersed vehicle camping in national or state parks.

Cruises, canoeing, fishing, kayaking, stand up paddle boarding, sailing, swimming, wakeboarding and waterskiing all abound on the waters of the Murray River and Lake Mulwala.

With over 50 popular fishing locations in the region, throw a line in for the chance to catch your very own fish of the day. Along with the prized Cod, you might also hook a Yellowbelly, Redfin or Silver Perch, among many other native and introduced species.

THE MURRAY FARM GATE TRAIL

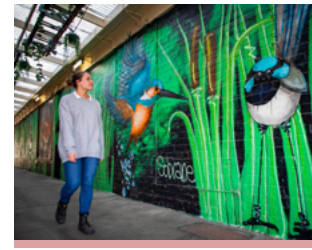
